**Subject:** APCO / NENA Nominating Committee Recommendations

As was reported in the April 12<sup>th</sup> e-newsletter, the APCO/NENA nominating committee was seeking qualified candidates who wish to serve these organizations in a leadership role. A recommendation will be made at the June Chapter meeting to merge the Washington Chapters of APCO & NENA and adopt new bylaws for governing a combined association. If combined bylaws are not approved, elections will be held separately for both organizations. Should separate elections be held, the APCO positions available are: **President Elect, Secretary, and Westside Member at Large**. If the combined bylaws are approved, the following positions will be available: **President, President Elect, NENA Treasurer, Secretary, Eastside Member at Large and Westside Member at Large**. The nominating committee is preparing for both eventualities and is preparing to fill positions under both scenarios.

According to the current by-laws, this nomination report must be made to the membership at least 60 days prior to the election. Additional nominations can be added to the ballot upon request of four Active Chapter members delivered to the Secretary 15 days prior to the election.
