Establishment of the Chapter

11/04/1944 Chartered as "Northwest Chapter" including Alaska, Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, and the northern part of Utah

08/10/1965 Re-chartered as a result of change in APCO name from "Police" to "Public Safety"

1996 Amended to the "Washington State Chapter"

Persons Who were involved in the formation of the Chapter

The names on the charter are Dick Quantz, Clarence Williams, W.A. Gebenini, Ero Erickson, and Frank W. Walker. The chapter has a scholarship honoring Dick Quantz funded by ADCOMM Engineering. The scholarship was set up to assist technicians in furthering their careers. Dick went on to become one of the APCO International's Presidents, serving from 1965—1966.
